
Sub:- Guidelines for admission in Primary, Middle & Secondary

The Right of Children to Free & Compulsory Education (RTE) Act, 2009 and the Goa Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2012 provide for neighborhood schooling and prohibiting screening procedure for admission in schools.

Taking into account above factors in consideration, the Government has approved the new guidelines for admission in Schools for its implementation from the academic year 2018-19 and onwards. Copy enclosed.

This supersedes all previous guidelines for admission in Primary, Middle and Secondary School in the State.

School Specific points.

1. Parents should be informed well in advance of the school specific points and the marks allotted to each point.
2. Priority to be given to candidates who have excelled in sports at state/district/National level.
3. Preference should be given to children who have excelled in extra curricular activities and talent examination.
4. Priority to be given to children of ex-servicemen.

For the schools shifted to integrated Educational Complex, the distance shall be from the place of their original location.
