


C I R C U L A R

Instances have come to the notice of the Department, wherein transfers of students are being allowed from one school to another in Std. X. Most of the time, this transfer is from Govt. aided schools to Govt. schools. There may be many reasons for such transfer. Such transfer in Std. X changes the atmosphere of the students, making it more difficult for him to cope up with the studies. In most parts of the Country, the students are not allowed admission in Std. X in normal circumstances. Such transfers are allowed only in case of transfer of parents from one state to another, etc.

The matter was examined by the Government, particularly in light of the fact that many students who were not good at studies, were transferred in Government Schools by Government Aided / Unaided schools. It has been decided by the Government, that the schools will not take admission in Std. X and the students admitted in Class IX will continue their studies in the same school in Class IX as well as X. This will facilitate the students to perform better in the same school with the help and support of the teachers and parents, with whom he is more familiar. It has therefore been decided that there will be no new admission in Class X. All Government Aided / Unaided / Government schools are therefore directed not to issue Transfer Certificate / Leaving Certificate to the students after IXth examination, as there will not be any admission in Std.X of such students. They are advised to continue with the same set of students in Std. IX and X as well.

This is for strict compliance of all concerned.
