CIRCULAR

As per the suggestions received from various institutions across Goa, most of the students do not prefer Sweet Moong Usal and Dry Chana Usal on Tuesday and Thursday respectively. Further, as per the directives received from Government of Goa, it is informed to strictly avoid serving items made of refined flour [Maida (Pav)] under PM POSHAN (Mid Day Meal) menu. Therefore, it has been decided by this office to make a slight change in the ongoing PM POSHAN (Mid Day Meal) menu. The modified menu is as follows:

Sr.No.	Days	Food items to be supplied (as per the following options)
1	Monday	Potato Bhaji with Chapati/ Mix vegetable Idli
2	Tuesday	Moong (Patal) Bhaji with Chapati/ Mix vegetable Pulav
3	Wednesday	Chole Chapati/ Mix Vegetable Idli
4	Thursday	Potato Bhaji with Chapati/ Mix Vegetable Pulav
5	Friday	Vatana Bhaji with Chapati/ Mix Vegetable Idli
6	Saturday	Veg. Kurma with Chapati/ Mix Vegetable Pulav

The menu shall either be wheat based item and rice based item on alternate basis. The options shall be exercised on discussion with PTA/SMC. All the Heads of institutions are hereby instructed to strictly adhere to the above menu.
