1. Vision

2. Objectives

Administration

Presently this Directorate is facing shortage of staff in Schools/Higher Secondary Schools and in subordinate offices/Head offices. Efforts are being made for assessment of staff which is in process with Administrative Reforms department no sooner finalised, filling up of post will be taken up.

Goa Samagra Shiksha Abhiyaan (GSSA)

Build up capacities of the academic ground level staff that is the CRPs and BRPs to face the challenges posed by the New Education Policy 2020 through suitable workshops. Thoroughly acquaint all GSS functionaries to the new 5+3+3+4 system of school education in place of old 10+2.

Vocational

To form team of experts to redesign Vocational courses so also maintain and monitor the quality of the Mid day Meals dealt by the section.

Statistics

To make Education Management Information System (EMIS) completely online. This is an annual activity of this Section in which information about various Schools is collected. The need is Technical support to design new software or need to buy new software, so also internet connectivity in all the schools.

District Institute of Education and Training (D.I.E.T)

Timely recruitment of Teacher Educators and other Administrative staff also as per requirement of New Education Policy 2020 and train teachers in tune with recent trends in Information and Technology.

Goa Education Development Corporation (GEDC)

Appointment of Nodal Officers in stake holder Department to ensure smooth functioning of schemes such as creation and enhancement of Infrastructure and overall development of Educational sector, so also constituting a competent and Technical sub-committee to deal with matters of considering and deciding on excess expenditure.

State Council of Educational Research and Training (S.C.E.R.T)

To undertake academic reforms in light of policy changes. To co-ordinate with NCERT, NUEPA and other National and International and State level agencies including NGO's for implementation of Schemes and projects.

The need is deployment of qualified academic staff, shortage of Resource persons (RP), and absence of separate cadre of teacher educators in the State.

3. Short Term Goals

To accomplish all the spelt out objections of each of the above sections / organs/ departments of the Directorate of Education in tandem with the vision of the department.
